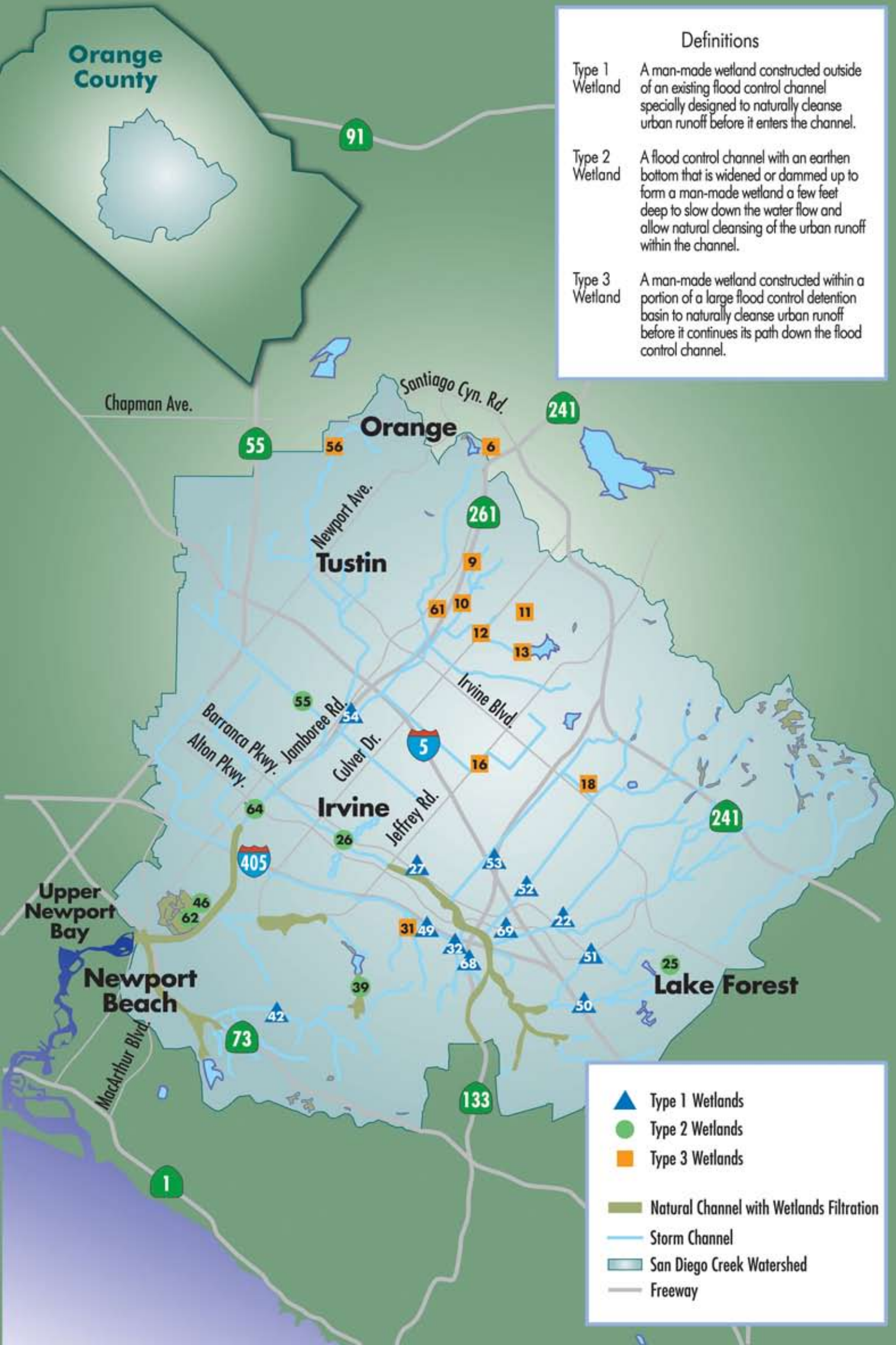


## Definitions

- Type 1 Wetland** A man-made wetland constructed outside of an existing flood control channel specially designed to naturally cleanse urban runoff before it enters the channel.
- Type 2 Wetland** A flood control channel with an earthen bottom that is widened or dammed up to form a man-made wetland a few feet deep to slow down the water flow and allow natural cleansing of the urban runoff within the channel.
- Type 3 Wetland** A man-made wetland constructed within a portion of a large flood control detention basin to naturally cleanse urban runoff before it continues its path down the flood control channel.
