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REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: The effects of the proposed project are Categorically Exempt from the requirements to prepare additional environmental documentation per California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, Section 15303, Class 3 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures). The Class 3 Exemption consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure. The proposed project would construct an approximately 6,100 square feet (sq. ft.) unconditioned storage warehouse building, an approximately 3,300 sq. ft. canopy cover structure and an approximately 1,500 sq. ft. water quality storage building. Additionally, the proposed project would include reconfiguration of existing storage racks and water quality storage containers within the project site. The proposed project would result in construction of small facilities and structures that would expand IRWD's MWRP's warehouse capacity and allow for efficient storage and retrieval of warehouse materials. In addition, pursuant to Section 15300.2 (c) and 15301 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations, there are no unusual circumstances in respect to the proposed project for which staff would anticipate a significant effect on the environment.

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
