Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) constructed a recycled water pipeline to interconnect IRWD and Orange County Water District (OCWD) recycled water systems as a part of the Green Acres Project (GAP) in 1997. The pipeline is located on University Drive between Jamboree Road and the 73 Freeway overpass. Prior to 2011, IRWD owned and maintained the pipeline upstream of the intertie metering structure and OCWD owned and maintained the segment downstream of the metering structure. In 2011, IRWD took over ownership of the GAP pipeline segment between the metering structure and Jamboree Road. This project will construct a Cathodic Protection system to protect against corrosion of the additional 1310 feet of the existing GAP pipeline between the intertie metering vault and Jamboree Road.


