

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) owns, operates and maintains numerous facilities, located throughout its service area, including the Bonita Canyon Zone D to Zone B Pressure Reducing Station (PRS). The Bonita Canyon Zone D to Zone B PRS is located on Bonita Canyon Drive between California State Route 73 and Newport Coast Drive in IRWD's Newport Coast service area. A 12-inch recycled water pipeline, which supplies the Zone D recycled water system to the Zone B recycled water system via the Bonita Canyon Zone D to Zone B PRS, is leaking and requires replacement.

This project will include the abandonment of the existing recycled water supply pipeline and the installation of approximately 135 linear feet, 12-inch replacement pipeline. The section of the 12-inch recycled water pipeline that will be replaced is located in front of the Bonita Canyon Pump Station and crosses perpendicularly both westbound lanes of Bonita Canyon Drive. This project will install the replacement pipeline and will also abandon the existing pipeline in place.




EXHIBIT "A" LOCATION MAP
