How to Get Free Water This Summer

IRWD is giving out free water—well, recycled water. That's right, all IRWD customers are eligible to receive free recycled water to use for non-potable purposes, such as watering your landscape. To date, IRWD customers have taken delivery of more than 180,000 gallons of free recycled water.

To participate, first-time visitors must provide a California driver license, an IRWD water bill and a completed application form. Customers must also provide their own containers.

Fire-Resistant Plants

Q: What are some drought friendly and fire resistant plants that I can establish in the landscape of my house in the foothills?

A: Good question. IRWD customers who live in the foothill and canyon areas are more vulnerable to fires and would benefit from including fire

resistant plants in their landscape. Below are a few options for homeowners to consider when planting this autumn or winter:

Shrubs

- Monkey flower (*Mimulus sp*)
- California lilac (*Ceanothus sp*)
- Autumn sage (*Salvia greggii*)

Trees

- Coast live oak (*Quercus agrifolia*)
- California sycamore (*Platanus racemosa*)
- Toyon (*Heteromeles arbutifolia*)
