How You Can Help California By Saving Water

Governor asks California to reduce water use by 25%. What these mandates mean for you.

What did the Governor mandate?

Governor Jerry Brown issued an Executive Order on April 1, 2015 calling on the State Water Resources Control Board and several other state agencies, to take emergency action to impose mandatory statewide water restrictions in response to the ongoing drought conditions in California.

The proposed savings requirement by the State Water Resources Control Board for IRWD is 16%. IRWD will be working closely with the State Water Resources Control Board to define how these savings can be accomplished and what this will mean for IRWD customers.

IRWD will be following the new water restriction mandates carefully and will post information at **www.irwd.com/drought** as it becomes available.

What should IRWD customers do right now to help California save water?

There are three important things that IRWD customers can do right now to help save water. Recognizing that between 60 to 65 percent of household water is used outside, we are asking our customers to focus on saving water outside of your home by immediately:

- Checking Your Sprinkler Timer. Are you over watering your yard? Is your sprinkler timer set correctly? Are the batteries still working? IRWD offers an easy to follow guide as well as a self-help video on our website on how to take control of your outdoor irrigation sprinklers.
- **Removing Water-Thirsty Turf.** Say goodbye to water-thirsty turf and get a rebate to help with the costs. The Turf Removal Rebate offers up to \$2 per square feet of grass removed.
- Fixing Water Leaks. Checking for leaks is easy and can be one of the most effective ways to use water wisely. Follow our self help videos on our website to learn how to do this. It's easy and it will save you both water and money.





- Take shorter showers.


Suggested Weekly Watering Schedule
