Is That a Real IRWD Employee?

If someone knocks on your door claiming to be an IRWD employee or contractor, don't be afraid to ask for identification. If you have any doubts, call 949-453-5300. Keep in mind:

- All IRWD employees carry photo I.D. badges and must show them on request.
- Most IRWD field crew members wear an IRWD uniform with the IRWD logo above the left-hand shirt pocket and the employee's name on the right side.

- Many but not all IRWD employees will drive an IRWD vehicle when reporting to a customer's home for a service call or appointment.
- IRWD will never try to sell you anything.
- IRWD employees and contractors will not show up to your home without an appointment, except for emergencies, service starts or stops, and meter repair or replacement.
- IRWD works with several contractors that provide various services to the District's customers; no contractor should be on your property without an agreed-upon appointment.

Two New WaterStars Shine

IRWD recently honored **Hoag Hospital Irvine** and **Chapman University's Rinker Health Education Campus** as WaterStars – Certified Water-Efficient Businesses. Hoag installed low-flow fixtures and faucets and automatic flush

Businesses. Hoag installed low-flow fixtures and faucets and automatic flush valves, uses water-efficient instrument sterilization, and maintains low water use in its cooling towers and boilers. Hoag's recycled-water drip irrigation system is activated by weather-based controllers. Combined indoor and outdoor conservation measures save Hoag more than five million gallons of water annually. The Rinker campus installed efficient fixtures, swapped turf for drought-tolerant plants, and upgraded to smart weather-based irrigation controllers. Savings: two million gallons per year, with more anticipated as remaining turf is replaced.

Q: I have a small 6' x 9' patio. All of the plants are succulents. I would like a single pot with two to three flowering plants for some color. What would you recommend?

A: When it comes to growing plants in containers, remember to always check the soil moisture. Drought-tolerant plants or not, if the soil becomes too dry, the plants may go into shock, wilt and possibly not come back. Lavender (*Lavandula spp.*) and rosemary

(*Rosmarinus spp.*) are good choices. Lantana is also good. Always consider the exposures when selecting plants. Happy gardening!
