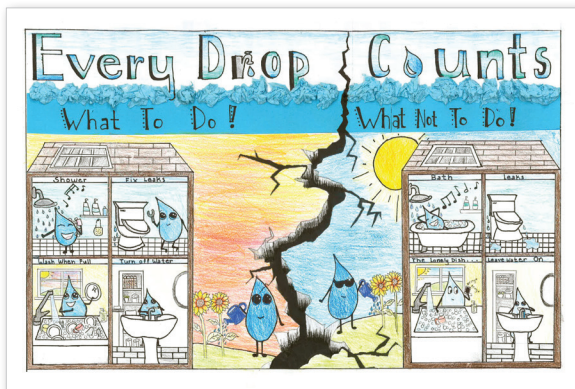




Enter the Annual Water Awareness Poster Contest!

Create a poster that shows how to use water wisely at home, school, business or in agriculture, or show how saving water can help the environment. You could become a published artist!

Winning posters will be submitted to regional competitions sponsored by the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California and Municipal Water District of Orange County. Top posters may be selected to appear in the water awareness calendar for 2020.

Posters will be selected based on the originality and clarity of the message as well as the artistic level and the overall uniqueness. The posters will be judged within grades K-2, 3-5, 6-8 and 9-12, so everyone has a chance to win!

Poster Contest Rules – Read Carefully

- Open to students grades K-12 currently attending school within the IRWD service area.
- Use white art or construction paper. Poster paper available upon request
- Posters must be drawn HORIZONTALLY on 12 x 18 inch paper and include at least a one-inch, blank border around all four edges, or on 8-1/2 x 11 inch paper (no border required). **No other sizes will be accepted.**
- Crayons, markers, ink, poster paint, pastels, chalk, water-color, cut paper or fabric may be used.
- Include a short water message.
- Original artwork only – no copyrighted material such as Mickey Mouse, Spongebob, etc.
- Do not put the student's name on the front of the poster.
- Poster must be the hands-on work of the student only.
- Tape completed entry form to the back of poster. One entry form for each poster. Posters without the entry forms taped to the back cannot be accepted.
- All posters become the property of IRWD/MWDOC/MWD and may be displayed or reproduced.
