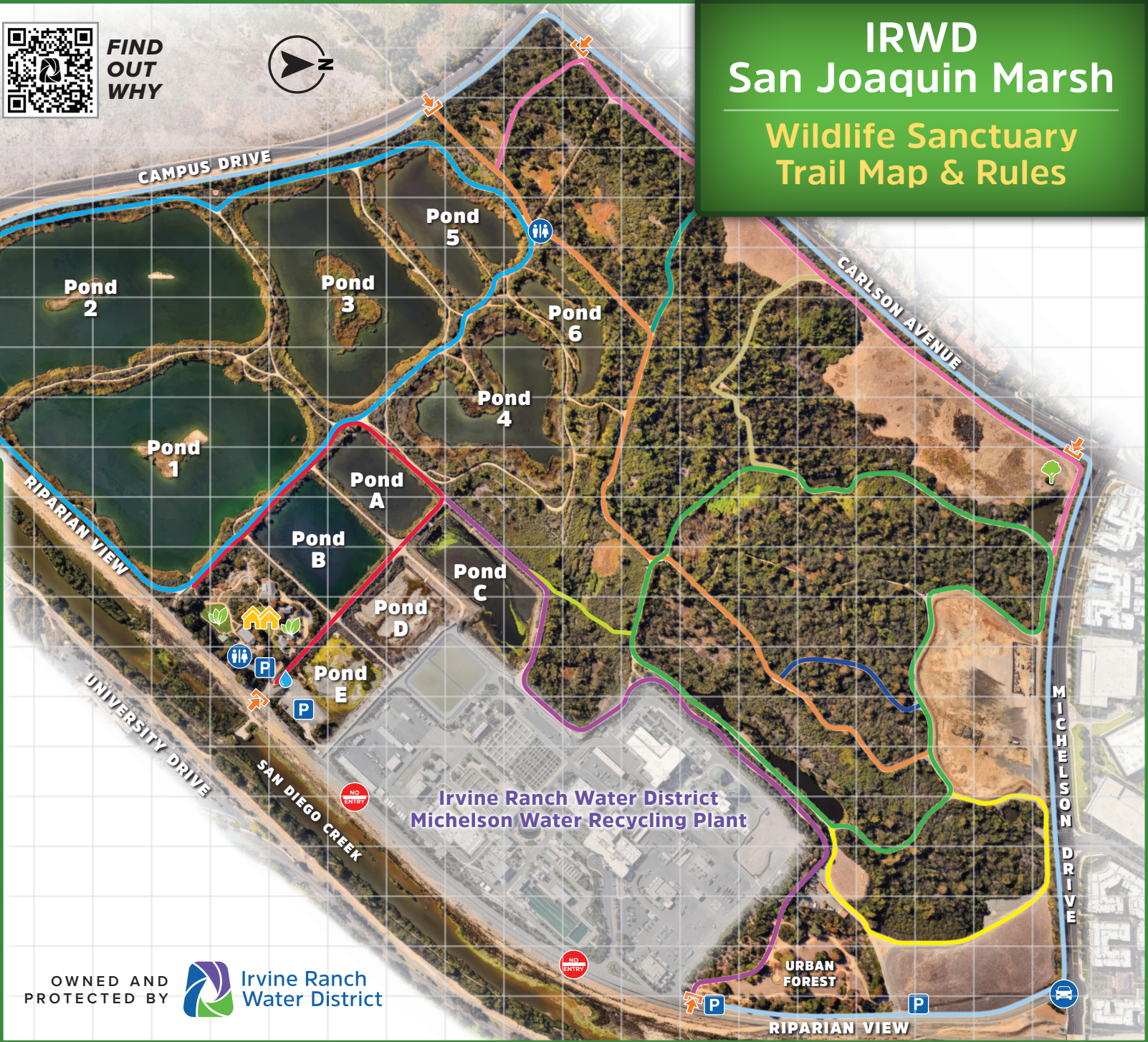

San Joaquin Marsh is a wildlife sanctuary and a place for quiet enjoyment. But visitors may be unaware of its true identity: a natural water treatment facility that protects environmentally sensitive Upper Newport Bay. Free to the public, it offers more than 12 miles of trails for hiking, birdwatching, and nature study.

BE KIND TO THE MARSH AND ITS CREATURES

The Marsh provides a safe, welcoming environment for more than 300 species of birds and many other animals. You can help preserve this haven for wildlife and people.

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES:

-  **OPEN DAWN TO DUSK** - seven days a week
-  **STAY ON TRAILS** and obey all trail signs
-  **NO DOGS**, other pets, or horses
-  **NO BIKES** or motorized vehicles
-  **NO DRONES**
-  **NO SWIMMING**, wading, or boating
-  **DO NOT DISTURB** or collect wildlife or plants
-  **DO NOT FEED** the animals
-  **DO NOT RELEASE** any animals
-  **NO HUNTING**, fishing, trapping, or firearms
-  **NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS**
-  **NO SMOKING OR VAPING**
-  **DO NOT DRINK** the pond water
-  **NO CAMPING** or fires
-  **EVENTS ARE PROHIBITED** without prior approval of Irvine Ranch Water District
-  **PLEASE CARRY ALL TRASH OUT** with you, including food scraps
