## BE KIND TO THE MARSH AND ITS CREATURES

The marsh provides a safe, welcoming environment for more than 300 species of birds and many other animals. You can help preserve this haven for wildlife and people.

## PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES:

-  **OPEN DAWN TO DUSK** - seven days a week
-  **STAY ON TRAILS** and obey all trail signs
-  **NO DOGS**, other pets, or horses
-  **NO BIKES** or motorized vehicles
-  **NO DRONES**
-  **NO SWIMMING**, wading, or boating
-  **DO NOT DISTURB** or collect wildlife or plants
-  **DO NOT FEED** the animals
-  **DO NOT RELEASE** any animals
-  **NO HUNTING**, fishing, trapping, or firearms
-  **NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS**
-  **NO SMOKING OR VAPING**
-  **DO NOT DRINK** the pond water
-  **NO CAMPING** or fires
-  **EVENTS ARE PROHIBITED** without prior approval of Irvine Ranch Water District
-  **PLEASE CARRY ALL TRASH OUT** with you, including food scraps
