## California Native Plant Society Garden Tour

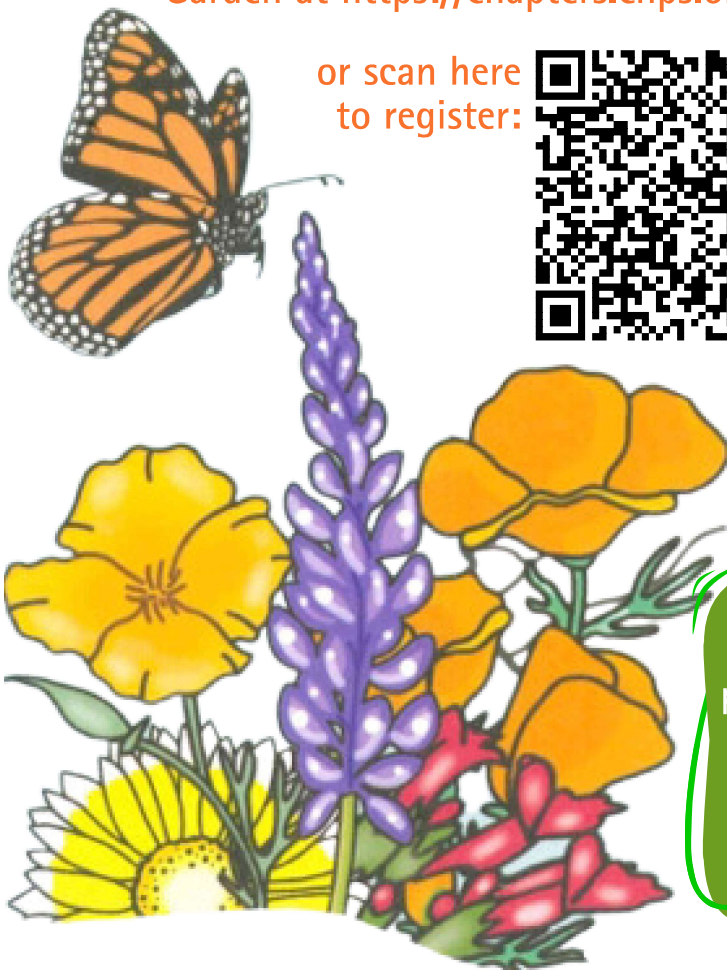
MAY 4TH - SOUTH COUNTY | MAY 5TH - NORTH COUNTY

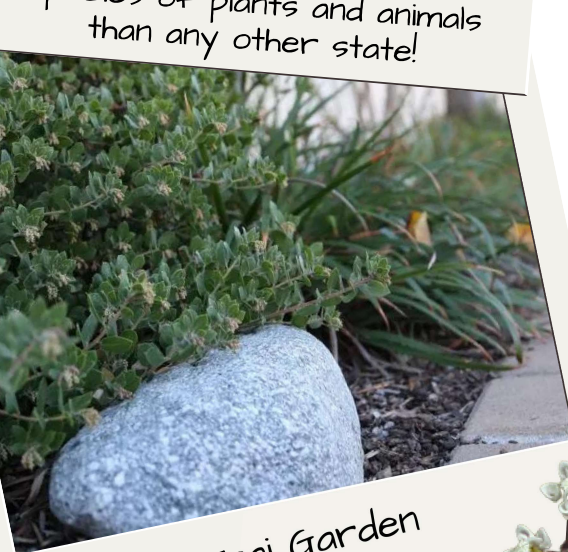
