

## **IRWD Pressure Regulating Spray Sprinkler Bodies Incentive Program**

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. I am applying to receive a rebate for pressure regulating spray sprinkler bodies under Irvine Ranch Water District's ("IRWD") Pressure Regulating Spray Sprinkler Bodies Incentive Program ("Program").
- 2. I understand that Program funding is available on a first-come, first-served basis while funding is available or until the Program is discontinued by IRWD. This Program will end when all allocated funds are depleted.
- 3. I certify that I am a residential, commercial, industrial or institutional customer of IRWD and devices submitted for rebate will be installed in IRWD's service area.
- 4. I certify that I have an existing operational irrigation system.
- 5. I understand IRWD will provide an incentive of 50 percent of the total actual device costs per account. The actual device costs exclude tax, shipping, labor and other charges.
- 6. I understand the devices purchased and installed under this Program must be listed on the IRWD Eligible Products List or approved by IRWD prior to purchase. IRWD does not warrant condition or the fitness of any specific devices on the Eligible Products List or any other approved devices for the applicant's purposes. IRWD's Eligible Products list, and any other approved devices under this Program, are approved only for the purpose of meeting IRWD standards as designed.
- 7. I understand that to be eligible for the rebate, a minimum quantity of at least 20 pressure regulating bodies for residential customers and 30 pressure regulating bodies for commercial and public agency customers must be purchased and installed. Customers requiring less than the minimum quantity of pressure regulating bodies will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis for program eligibility.
- 8. I understand the Program is for the installation of new equipment only. Receipts for irrigation components purchased through a third-party website (eBay, Amazon, etc.) must be submitted identifying the item as new. Like new or used irrigation components will not be reimbursed.
- 9. I understand rebate amounts and requirements are subject to change without advance notice.
- 10. I understand that I must complete and submit a program application and receive IRWD's approval <u>prior to</u> purchasing irrigation components listed on the IRWD Eligible Products List, in order to receive a rebate.
- 11. I understand IRWD may conduct a pre-inspection before approving my Program application.
- 12. I understand I will receive a Notice to Proceed via email after IRWD approves my application. I will not receive a rebate for equipment purchased prior to receipt of the Notice to Proceed.



- 13. I understand I must submit a post-installation affidavit when my project is complete to receive a rebate. The affidavit must include photos of installed pressure regulating spray sprinkler bodies (residential customers must submit 3-5 photos and commercial, industrial or institutional customers must submit 5-10 photos) and copies of actual/original, dated receipts for the pressure regulating spray sprinkler bodies.
- 14. I understand IRWD may conduct a post-installation inspection before my rebate is approved.
- 15. IRWD's inspections are for the purpose of verifying program compliance only, and IRWD will not be responsible for or ensure the suitability or adequacy of the installation work for the applicant's own purposes.
- <sup>16.</sup> I understand I must purchase and install pressure regulating spray sprinkler bodies within 60 days after receipt of my Notice to Proceed.
- 17. Renters may be eligible to participate with written consent of the property owner. Proof of the property owner's written consent must be submitted with the application.
- 18. A customer address for which a rebate was previously received through IRWD's programs is not eligible to receive another rebate for the same type of device. Irvine Ranch Water District verifies past participation using the information provided in the rebate application. It is the applicant's responsibility to provide accurate information (i.e. street name, unit/apartment number if applicable, etc.) to allow for proper past participation verification.
- 19. Program applications expire after 60 days unless the participant has requested, and IRWD has approved, an extension. All extension requests must be made in writing.
- 20. Rebate checks expire 90 days after being issued.
- 21. Irvine Ranch Water District reserves the right to approve or decline all applications.
- 22. A reduced water bill is not guaranteed.
- 23. Email addresses provided on the application may be used to communicate additional available rebates or programs by IRWD.
- <sup>24.</sup> By applying for a rebate in this Program, certain personal information listed on your application may be subject to disclosure to requesting parties pursuant to the California Public Records Act.
- 25. The Internal Revenue Service requires Rebate Program participants receiving \$600 or more in rebates to receive an IRS Form 1099 unless exemptions apply. If your rebate amount will exceed this threshold, the payee's Social Security or Tax ID number must be provided via a completed Form W-9 along with the rebate application paperwork in order to receive a rebate. The name on the W-9 must match the name on the rebate check. This form must be completed so Irvine Ranch Water District can properly complete the Form 1099. This requirement is in compliance with exemptions to the Federal Privacy Act of 1974, 42 UCS 405 (c)(2)(c). Social Security numbers provided as part of the application process are held in confidence under terms of the Privacy Act and are not divulged or otherwise conveyed to individuals or organizations outside IRWD.
